New Exhibit: Anne Sargent Walker, *Existential* March 10 - May 28, 2025

Brookline, Massachusetts, Gallery 93 at the Brookline Senior Center is pleased to present *Existential* by artist Anne Sargent Walker. The exhibit runs from March 10 - May 28, 2025. A reception for the artist will be held on Thursday March 20 from 1:30-3:00 pm with an artists' talk held at 2:00 pm. Gallery 93, located at 93 Winchester Street, Brookline, MA, is open from 8:30-5:00, Monday through Friday.

Painter Anne Sargent Walker's work investigates our environments' fragile balance and our human impact on it. She has a clear love of the animals and plants that reside in the world and points to the beauty and heartache of the degradation of much of the natural world. She states of her work: "The surface content of birds, flora and other creatures often degrades, peels back, dissolves or drips to reveal layers underneath, suggesting the planet's warming, loss of habitat, species, the earth itself and of course us." Birds appear often in Walker's work and while there is melancholy present, I believe there are glimmers of hope as the birds take flight and find their way. Perhaps we humans can find our way, taking the lead from mother earth.

Anne Sargent Walker grew up in the Boston area and Vermont and has degrees from Connecticut College and Tufts University. She has been awarded residencies in Ireland, Italy and Vermont and has been awarded a Berkshire Taconic Foundation Artist's Resource Trust grant. Her work has been shown extensively in New England and collected internationally, including Fidelity Corporation, Waterway Capital, and Twin Farms Resort. She has been reviewed in Artscope Magazine and Cape Cod Arts, among others. Anne is an Associate member of the Kingston Gallery in Boston. Her most recent show was Bird Stories/Human Narratives at ConcordArt in Concord MA, summer of 2024.
